

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-0-24

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 1252.11(c)
REGARDING FENCES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS AND
REQUIREMENTS FOR ERECTION OF FENCES**

WHEREAS, Council wishes to amend Ordinance 1252.11(c) in order to allow a fence to be placed on a property line and also requiring that before any fence is erected the property pins must be located or a survey must be obtained.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mentor-on-the-Lake, County of Lake and State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That Codified Ordinance Section 1252.11(c) is amended and as amended Section 1252.11(c) hereby reads as follows:


(c) Display and Erection of Fence. All fences shall be erected so that the finished or decorative side of the fence faces away from the lot upon which the fence is being erected. The finished or decorative side of the fence shall at all times be displayed or erected so that the surface of the finished or decorative side is not directed toward the lot or home upon which the fence is being erected. A fence may be placed directly on the property line between two parcels.

No fence permit of any kind shall be issued where the installation of the fence abuts or establishes a property line unless the applicant for the fence permit locates the survey property pins where the fence is to be located and proves such fact to the Zoning Inspector at the time of applying for the fence permit. In the event that the property pins cannot be located, then before the fence permit can be issued for a fence that abuts or established a property line, the applicant for the fence permit shall have a boundary survey prepared and sealed by a surveyor registered in the State of Ohio so that property pins are established along the property line where the fence is to be located.


Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings

open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty day after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.


