

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-O-06

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT
WITH THE FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTERS AND AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH THE
MENTOR-ON-THE-LAKE FIRE FIGHTER'S
IAFF, LOCAL 3049, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City and the Mentor-on-the-Lake Firefighter's IAFF Local 3049, acting on behalf of the full-time firefighters of the City of Mentor-on-the-Lake, have engaged in collective bargaining negotiations and procedures pursuant to Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, said parties have effected a Memorandum of Understanding and a Wage Re-Opener Agreement for the period commencing January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Council has reviewed the terms of such agreement with the Administration, finds the same to be acceptable, and determines that it should be ratified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENTOR-ON-THE-LAKE, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council does hereby ratify said Articles and Sections as noted in the Memorandum of Understanding and the Wage Re-Opener Agreement, as amended, of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Mentor-on-the-Lake and the Mentor-on-the-Lake Firefighters IAFF Local 3049, for the period commencing January 1, 2021, pertaining to its full-time firefighters, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and the Mayor and Administrative Director are hereby authorized to execute such amendment on behalf of the City.

Section 2. That, all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to immediately implement the provisions of said Collective Bargaining Agreement. Said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mentor-on-the-Lake.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
