

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO
AGREEMENTS WITH THE CITY OF MENTOR FOR THE 2023 ROAD
PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration asked the City of Mentor to allow the Mentor on the Lake 2023 Road Program to be integrated and performed under the Mentor 2023 Pavement Repair Program because the unit prices for the 2023 Mentor Road Program would be substantially better than the prices that Mentor on the Lake would receive according to the Mentor on the Lake Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 9.482 permits Ohio Political Subdivisions to enter into contracts with other Ohio Political Subdivision in order to share services and to perform functions for the recipient political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Council determines it is in the best interests of the City to enter into an agreement with the City of Mentor so that the Mentor on the Lake 2023 Road Program can be integrated and performed under the Mentor 2023 Pavement Repair Program; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Agreements between the City of Mentor and the City of Mentor on the Lake are attached hereto as Exhibit A and B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENTOR ON THE LAKE, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Administrative Director is hereby authorized and directed to enter into Agreements with the City of Mentor that are substantially in the form of the Agreement that is attached as Exhibit 1.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have the 2023 Road Program performed at a reasonable price. Said Resolution is necessary for the health, safety and

well-being of the City of Mentor on the Lake; and this Resolution shall, therefore, take effect immediately upon its passage.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect as provided by law upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
