## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-30**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS ON BEHALF
OF THE CITY FOR OPWC ROUND 39 FUNDING
AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR
TO EXECUTE SUCH FORMS AND CONTRACTS AS
MAY BE REQUIRED TO PROPERLY SECURE OPWC ROUND 39
FUNDING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MENTOR ON THE LAKE,
LAKE COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio has made available funding for infrastructure improvements under Ohio Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of said funds is based upon project applications submitted to the District Seven Executive Committee and the Ohio Public Work Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mentor on the Lake has needed infrastructure projects for which such funding is desired.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENTOR ON THE LAKE, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Administrative Director and the City Engineer be, and are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit applications on behalf of the City of Mentor on the Lake for OPWC Round 39 funding as follows:

## Beech Drive Storm Outfall Repair

- <u>Section 2.</u> That the Mayor and the Administrative Director be and hereby are authorized to execute such forms and contracts as may be required to properly secure funding for the project hereinabove set forth.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the affairs of the City in a prudent and responsible manner and further to secure the said OPWC funding in a timely manner. Said Resolution is necessary for the health, safety and well-being of the City of Mentor on the Lake.

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
