

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-34**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE (July 1, 2024) OF THE LAKE COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the board of county commissioners of Lake County has established the Lake County Solid Waste Management District (the "District") and established and convened a "Solid Waste Management Policy Committee" (the "policy Committee") in accordance with section 3734 of the Revised Code to prepare a "Solid Waste Management Plan" (the "Plan") for the district as required by Section 343.54; and

**WHEREAS**, the Solid Waste Management District Policy Committee pursuant to law has reviewed the original Plan and it has issued a Plan Update for the original Plan. Further said Committee has adopted the aforesaid 5-year Solid Waste Plan Update as of July 1, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, upon receiving or determining approval of the 5-Year Update Plan by (1) the County Commissioners, (2) the legislative authorities of the municipal corporation having the largest population within the boundaries of the county of the district and (3) at least 60% of the population of the combined municipal corporations and townships within the district, the District Policy Committee must ratify the updated Solid Waste Management Plan prior to submitting it to Ohio EPA for approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENTOR-ON-THE-LAKE, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1.** The 5-Year Solid Waste Plan Update (July 2024) is approved in the form submitted to Council and presently on file with the Clerk of Council and Administration.

**Section 2.** The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to mail or otherwise deliver promptly a certified copy of this Resolution to the Solid Waste District Coordinator.

**Section 3.** That all formal actions of the Council concerning the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**WHEREFORE**, this resolution shall be in full force and defect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
