Carol Stafinski stated that the committee will have to follow the bus rules and wear masks. Mayor Eva volunteered to call the limousine company.

Samantha Wolfe suggested residents donate to Sub-Zero Mission <u>www.subzeromission.org</u> (new hats, gloves, scarves, coats and socks) to vote for the house they would like to win the Lighting Contest.

Next week information will be posted on Facebook to register for the contest, residents have to be registered by December 8<sup>th</sup>. Voting will be December 10<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>. Winners will be announced on December 21<sup>st</sup>.

Carol Stafinski spoke with a friend from Thompson. They received donations for their concerts of \$1,200 and used local talent. Thompson brings in UH Mobile to check vitals for people attending the concert. Mayor Eva again stated that it would be difficult to have a concert at Loba Park (Overlook Beach Park) with parking being an issue and no electric at the park. Michelle Moore also suggested that having a single porta potty might be a problem.

Samantha Wolfe contacted the Mentor-on-the-Lake Library, they do not have many programs for seniors. Most senior programs are at the main branch in Mentor.
